





REPORT ON INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO MASCO TEA FACTORY, VAGAMON

Introduction

On 19th October 2024, the Department of Commerce & Management Studies and ED Club of Paramekkavu College of Arts and Science, Thrissur organized an industrial visit to Masco Tea Factory, Vagamon. The objective of this visit was to provide students with hands-on experience and insights into the tea manufacturing process.

Masco Tea Factory

Masco Tea Factory, located in Vagamon, is a renowned tea processing unit in Kerala. It processes high-quality tea leaves from the surrounding plantations. The factory is equipped with modern machinery and employs skilled personnel to ensure efficient and hygienic tea production.

Key Observations and Learnings

During the visit, students were able to observe the entire tea manufacturing process, from the initial stage of withering to the final packaging of tea. The key observations and learnings are summarized below:

1. Tea Leaf Processing:

- Withering: Freshly plucked tea leaves are spread out on racks to reduce their moisture content. This process is crucial for the subsequent stages of tea production.
- **Rolling:** The withered leaves are rolled to rupture the cell walls and release enzymes, which contribute to the development of tea's flavour and aroma.
- **Fermentation:** Rolled leaves are oxidized in a controlled environment to develop the characteristic color and flavour of black tea.
- **Drying:** The fermented leaves are dried to remove excess moisture and fix the flavour and aroma.
- **Sorting and Grading:** The dried tea is sorted and graded based on leaf size and quality.
- **Packaging:** The graded tea is packed in airtight containers for distribution.

2. Quality Control:

- **Tea Testing:** Samples of tea are regularly tested in the factory's quality control laboratory to ensure that they meet the required standards.
- **Sensory Evaluation:** Trained tasters assess the color, aroma, and taste of tea to evaluate its quality.

3. Factory Management:

- **Production Planning:** The factory has a well-defined production plan to ensure efficient utilization of resources.
- **Inventory Management:** Effective inventory management is crucial for maintaining a steady supply of raw materials and finished products.
- **Quality Assurance:** The factory emphasizes quality assurance throughout the entire production process.

4. Sustainability:

- Waste Management: The factory implements proper waste management practices to minimize environmental impact.
- **Social Responsibility:** Masco Tea Factory is committed to social responsibility and supports local communities.

Conclusion

The industrial visit to Masco Tea Factory provided students with a valuable opportunity to understand the intricacies of tea production. 



Details of the Programme

The Department of Commerce and Management, in collaboration with the Nature Club, IIC, and IQAC, successfully organized a workshop on sustainable living focused on paper bag and Crochet Making. The event aimed to promote eco-friendly practices and raise awareness about reducing plastic waste. Participants engaged in hands-on activities, learning to create reusable paper bags and Crochet Making using recycled materials. The workshop fostered creativity and teamwork while emphasizing the importance of sustainable choices. The atmosphere was collaborative, with attendees enthusiastically following along and asking questions. By the end of the session, participants had successfully created their own small crochet pieces, such as coasters and bookmarks. The workshop was both informative and enjoyable, providing a relaxing, hands-on experience while encouraging a deeper appreciation for the craft of crochet. Total 22 students participated in this workshop.


English Department Seminar
